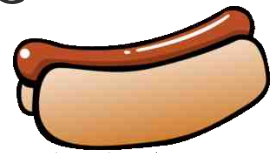

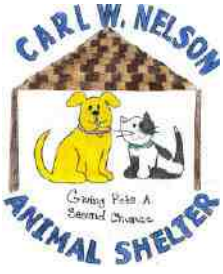

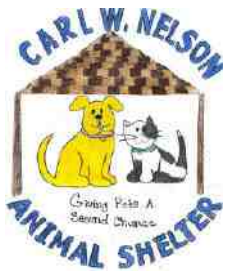
relay. Members of the team were Adam Nelson, Mike Hunkins, Mikayla Hunkins, and Jacob Hunkins.

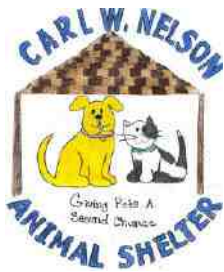

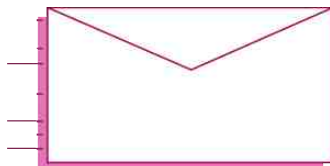

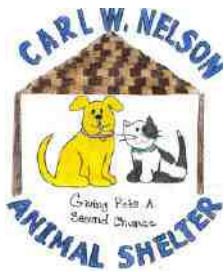

Solo, SweetPea, and Seven were abandoned in Mauston this winter. They were in very poor condition when they were found, but with loving care in a foster home, they are now healthy.

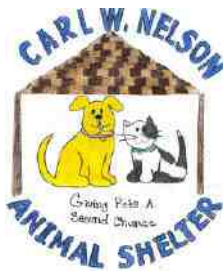
Despite their poor beginning, these are amazing cats. They love to play and get into trouble. Though Seven was

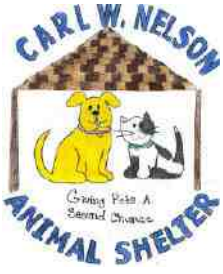

Board Member Attends Wisconsin Animal Law Conference

CWNAS Treasurer, Terry Dalla Valle, attended the Wisconsin Animal Law conference, at the Osthoff Resort and Conference Center in Elkhart Lake, WI on March 20. The event was sponsored by The WI Puppy Mill Project and WI Federated Humane Societies. The conference focused on the recent puppy mill legislation, Assembly Bill 250.



Dr. Yvonne Bellay, Animals Welfare Program Manager and Staff Epidemiologist for the Dept of Agriculture, Trade & Consumer Protection's (DATCP)-Animal Health Division, was one of the speakers. Also speaking were Jeff Smith, past WI State Assembly representative for the 93rd district, who authored and navigated AB250, (now Act 90), through the WI State Legislature, and Patricia Blaschka, who is in the property and casualty insurance industry and whose primary focus was shelter insurance.

Information pertaining to the following legal issues relating to animal sheltering were discussed:

WI Act 90 Administrative Rule and Certificates of Veterinary Inspection; WI Statute 95 which includes laws on animal health; WI Statute 173 pertaining to animals, humane officers, and reference to WI dog licensing law; WI Statute 174 pertaining to importation of dogs from out of states; WI Statute 951 pertaining to crimes against animals; and insurance options for animal organizations.

Note to our readers: CWNAS board members who attend educational conferences do so at their own expense.
