### READ TO ROVER IS BACK AT HATCH LIBRARY

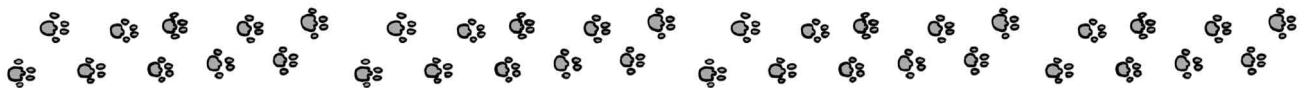

All of the dogs are trained to sit quietly while the children read to them and are certified by Therapy Dogs International. Children enjoy the relaxed atmosphere, and nonjudgmental presence of the dog while they improve their reading



Ryker Jarosz reads to Lily, a certified therapy dog at the Read to Rover program, sponsored by CWNAS

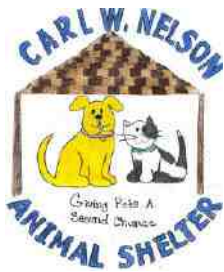

### Dog's Rule Kennel Donates Fencing To CWNAS

Greg Bova and Kathy McNally-Bova have decided to sell Dog's Rule Kennel and move to something smaller. Prior to being a boarding kennel it was called Dog's Rule Shelter. The Bovas started using their garage to house the stray dogs of Juneau County in April of 2000. They expanded and opened a boarding kennel in 2001.



The shelter offered these dogs a safe place to live, along with veterinary care, until they could be adopted. Kathy not only operated the shelter but also picked up the stray dogs at any time of the day or night. After nine years of service and about 2,000 strays, Dog's Rule Shelter was closed in November 2009.

Greg & Kathy have been supporters of the Carl W. Nelson Animal Shelter since it began and recently they decided to donate 1,400 ft of chain link fencing to us. We just had to remove it from their property. With a shortage of strong volunteers, CWNAS turned to the Juneau County Sheriff's Department and requested help from the Huber inmates. The volunteers helped cut away weeds, remove and roll up the fencing, and dig up the support posts. Some of these posts had been set in concrete, these had to be pulled by tractor and the concrete had to be chiseled off by hand.



Lots of time and tons of hard work were required to complete this project, so we would like to sincerely thank the following volunteers and equipment donors:
